<b>Purpose</b>	To be involved in all regulatory aspects assigned to the Commission for the Protection from Ionising and Non-Ionising Radiation

#### **Duties and responsibilities**

- Implementation of the management system, procedures and other documentation of the Secretariat, identifying any problems/failures and recommending/formulating corrective actions/suggestions to solve/improve it.
- Inspections of the various facilities and preparation of inspection reports.
- Assist in carrying out interviews and accident investigation.
- Updating Commission databases.
- Maintaining radiation monitoring equipment.
- Provide support in the event of detection of radioactive material at ports.
- Promotion of safety culture and radiation protection principles and subsidiary legislation with various stakeholders.
- Maintain documentation for the import/export of radioactive material.
- To participate in any work assigned to the Commission with respect to the regulation of non-ionising radiation.
- Drive a service vehicle as and when required.
- Be prepared for overseas training and to represent the Commission at meetings.
- To assist in the radioanalytical laboratory for environmental monitoring

The Executive Secretary may issue assign other duties and responsibilities that he may consider appropriate to the Employee for the proper performance of the Employee's duties.
